

SurroundArt opens facility in Dulles for storage of artwork

SurroundArt has opened an art-storage vault in Dulles to serve collectors, galleries, artists and museums.

The facility, built in 2006, has been updated to provide full climate and humidity control and a sophisticated security system that features camera surveillance and coded alarms.

“The proximity to Dulles [airport] makes our new art-storage facility a valuable commodity,” said SurroundArt CEO Michael Murray. “Shipping fine art and artifacts by air can be a stressful endeavor. Offering this service right at a major international airport removes one concern in our clients’ logistics planning.”

The storage facility is backed up with a generator system and can be used 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
